*If a police officer asks to search your car or backpack,
politely say: "I DO NOT CONSENT TO A SEARCH."*

DO NOT CONSENT



STOPPED BY POLICE?

Remember these lines:

1. **"OFFICER, AM I FREE TO GO?"**
2. **"OFFICER, I DO NOT CONSENT TO ANY SEARCHES."**
3. **"OFFICER, I WANT TO SPEAK WITH A LAWYER."**

Always be polite yet assertive. Never escalate a situation.

SEARCH WARRANTS

*Never let a police officer into your home without a search warrant. If they have one, check the address, date & the judge's signature. If the police knock at your door, step outside and close the door behind you to talk. Do not leave the door open. If they enter your home to search say, **"I DO NOT CONSENT TO A SEARCH."***
