GOVERNMENT'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

The United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA or the Government), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby moves this Tribunal for a brief continuance of 30 days of all scheduled deadlines in this matter.

The Tribunal's powers allow it to enter a continuance or stay. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 556(c)(5) (the Tribunal may "regulate the course of the hearing"); *see also* 21 C.F.R. § 1316.52. The Government believes that a brief continuance is warranted in this matter to allow the Government more time to evaluate the issues raised in Panacea Plant Sciences' (Panacea) Motion to Compel Publication of Notice, Stay of Proceedings, as well as other related and attendant legal issues.
