**GOVERNMENT'S NOTICE REGARDING

The United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA or the Government), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby files this notice to inform the Tribunal that on August 29, 2022, the Agency published in the Federal Register a Withdrawal of Proposed Rule (the Withdrawal). By the Withdrawal, DEA has “withdraw[n] the proposed rule published in the Federal Register on April 11, 2022 (87 FR 21069), and . . . terminate[d] all proceedings related thereto.” Accordingly, the Agency has terminated these proceedings.¹
